 - We apologize, the site is incorrect and it should all be in USD.
- In order to develop a qualitative proposal, could we have more information about the estimated LoE or budget for this project?
 - The budget on the IUCN procurement provides an estimated window of between 50,000-100,000 USD for this call.
- Please can you confirm what the submission time is for this opportunity. Is this 5pm (SAST) on the 14 July 2023?
 - The submission timeline closes on 14 July 2023 at 11:59pm CEST.
- on eligibility conditions. How are we going to demonstrate the following in the bid documents?
 - Not been convicted of failing to comply with environmental regulatory requirements or other legal requirements relating to sustainability and environmental protection
 - Not bankrupt or being wound up
 - Never been guilty of an offense concerning your professional conduct.
 - Not involved in fraud, corruption, a criminal organisation, money laundering, terrorism, or any other illegal activity.
 - The supporting documentation to certify compliance with these points is, essentially, the Declaration of Undertaking, which states that it complies with these requirements. Evidently this is based on "good faith", the person declares by signing the Declaration not to have a conflict of interest or to have incurred in any sanctionable practice. IUCN can also verify that the consultant company or person is not on the sanction list of the UN, World Bank etc.

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
