

MPA Program(s) Description or Highlights:

- 42% of the EEZ under MPAs: marine reserves, parks and multiple uses areas.
- Most of the surface represents few offshore large-scale MPAs.
- MPAs are managed by the Fishery Agency and the Ministry of the
- Environment.
- Design of surveillance/enforcement and biological monitoring programs.

Key Program Challenges/Priorities:

- Approve a bill in the Congress to create the new Biodiversity and Protected Areas Service
