	Group Type	Use and Description

1	Steering Committee <i>Comité Directivo</i> <i>Comité directeur</i>	Leads the activities of the Commission. Composed of individuals nominated by Commission Chair, and approved by IUCN Council.
2	Chair Office <i>Oficina del Presidente</i> <i>Bureau du président</i>	Composed of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Commission Chair, Commission Deputy Chair, and Commission Executive Officer • Other individuals invited by the Commission Chair
3	Regional ● <i>Regional</i> <i>Régional</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Commission members are linked to a Commission region according to their registered Country of residence. • Each Commission has a specific geographic mapping.
4	Young Professionals ● <i>Jóvenes Profesionales</i> <i>Jeunes professionnels</i>	Composed of all Commission members who are aged 35 or under at Commission application approval or Commission renewal completion.
5	Inter-Commission ● <i>Inter-Comisión</i> <i>Inter-Commission</i>	Is named as an IUCN Group without specific Commission acronym; the Group membership is an amalgamation of participating Groups from one or more Commissions.
6	Committee <i>Comité</i> <i>Comité</i>	Mandated to undertake a specific body of work by a Steering Committee.
7	Thematic Group <i>Grupo Temático</i> <i>Groupe thématique</i>	Works on broad areas of enquiry and key directions towards meeting the Commission mandate. CEC, CEESP, WCEL, WCPA: each Thematic Group is mapped to one Network.
8	Specialist Group <i>Grupo de Especialistas</i> <i>Groupe de spécialistes</i>	Works on long term activities relating to specific topics of study addressed by the Commission mandate. CEC, CEESP, WCEL, WCPA: each Speciality Group is mapped to one Network.
9	Authority <i>Autoridad</i> <i>Autorité</i>	Implements a body of work related to an agreed IUCN Standard on behalf of a Commission. SSC (IUCN Red List of Threatened Species), CEM (IUCN Red List of Ecosystems), CEESP (Knowledge baskets), etc.
10	Task Force <i>Grupo de Tarea</i> <i>Groupe d'étude</i>	Works on a specific issue, usually within a determined time period. CEC, CEESP, WCEL, WCPA: each Task Force is mapped to one Network.
11	Working Group <i>Grupo de Trabajo</i> <i>Groupe de travail</i>	Works on a specific issue or area of activity, mandated by a Steering Committee, Committee, Thematic Group, Specialist Group or Task Force.
12	Network <i>Red</i> <i>Réseau</i>	CEC, CEESP, WCEL, WCPA: Commission members choose to join a Network according to their interests or expertise.
13	Alliance <i>Alianza</i> <i>Alliance</i>	Applies when a Commission is working in partnership with other organisations on a specific topic (Statutes, Reg 71 refers). Composed of one representative from each partner organisation.
14	Organizational <i>Organizacional</i> <i>Organisationnel</i>	System only - Internal to Secretariat for IUCN systems interoperability.
