Creating transformative responses to the biodiversity and climate crisis in Africa

IUCN, the International Union for Conservation of Nature is convening the Africa Conservation Forum (ACF) which is one of the leading regional platforms to strategically influence the sustainability agenda and biodiversity conservation. The Forums brings together IUCN Members and multi stakeholders to discuss some of the most pressing environmental conservation issues in Africa. It also provides an avenue for sharing information and knowledge, building partnerships, and connecting key stakeholders from different parts of Africa.

The IUCN Africa Conservation Forum is organised by the three IUCN offices according to sub-regions in Africa: West and Central Africa (PACO), North Africa (Centre for Mediterranean Cooperation - MED), and Eastern and Southern Africa (ESARO).



Objective

The ACF, co-hosted by IUCN and the Government of Kenya through the Ministry of Tourism and Wildlife, seeks to amplify African Voices and find solutions that will support the global sustainability agenda.
