

Jaime Ubilla (PhD) is a lawyer, legislative advisor and professor of law at Universidad Católica del Norte, focused on legal theory, legal sociology, property rights and new post-modern strategies for social change with special emphasis on biodiversity law.

His theoretical and legislative advisory work is based on his theory on the 'reflexive form of law' (Ubilla, 2016), developed through his PhD research at the University of Edinburgh, United Kingdom. He also holds a M.A. in Law from Waseda University and a J.D. from Universidad de Chile.
