The IUCN Red List of Ecosystems



The IUCN Red List of Ecosystems (RLE) aims to build a better understanding of ecosystems at risk to support quick and effective conservation action at global and national levels. By identifying ecosystems at high risk of collapse and associated risk factors, the RLE supports informed conservation decision making with the aim of improved resource use and management.

Participants will learn the scientific foundations of the Red List of Ecosystems and take part in exploring its potential across different scales and types of ecosystems. Events will showcase examples of its application to date and engage participants in exploring opportunities for it to help monitor the status of our Planet and inform decisions and policies around biodiversity conservation and sustainable development.

Red List of Ecosystems

This journey offers the opportunity to learn on what IUCN and its Members are doing on the Red List of Ecosystems. You have the opportunity to learn the technical details on its categories and criteria, as well as discuss on the applications of the tool across regions and the links between Red List of Ecosystems and other knowledge products such as Red List of Species. 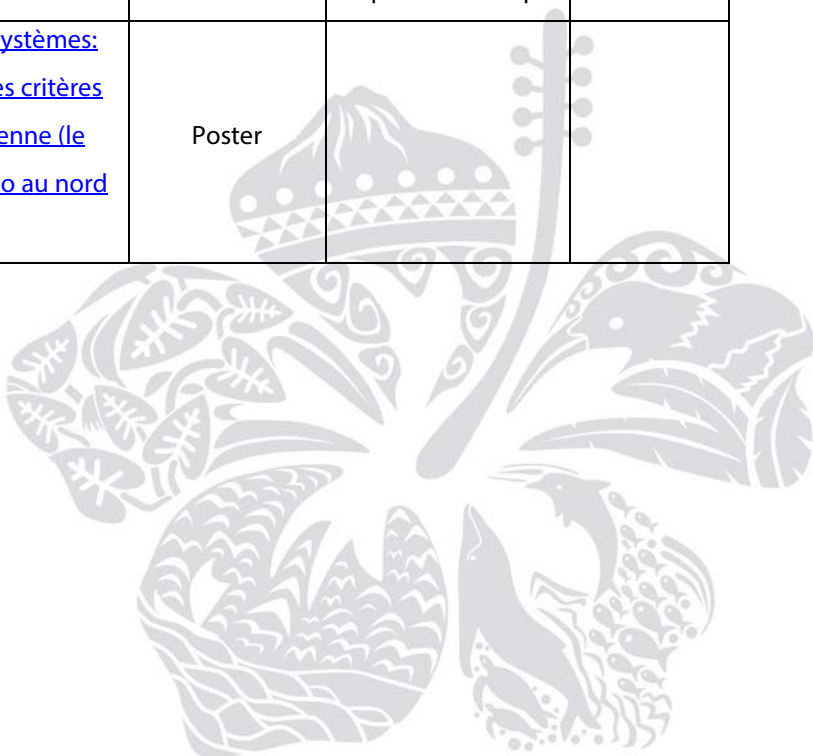
