The IUCN Green List programme is growing by fully deploying IUCN's 'One Programme'ⁱ approach – actively engaging with IUCN government and NGO Members, Commission Members, and partners.

GLOBAL

- The Operations Team had a virtual meeting on 01 February where key topics included the implementation of the re-listing procedure, as well as implications for sites for application of Version 1.1 of the Standard and User Manual. Sites can contact their regional/country focal points for any queries.
- Operations Team members and implementing partners received additional training on COMPASS (Community of Protected Areas Sustainability Standard, the cloud-based information management portal used by the Green List community) on EAGL member access, indicator adaptations, and site information uploading (webinar recordings are available on COMPASS).
- Version 1.1 of the User Manual has been circulated to the Management Committee for approval, which is expected following their quarterly meeting next month in March.

REGIONAL

- **Australia:** The EAGL has been trained on Version 1.1 of the Standard, the User Manual and COMPASS, and are in the process of adapting indicators for application by pilot phase sites and new protected and conserved areas committing to the Green List programme.
- **Malaysia:** The EAGL has completed indicator adaptation and will be conducting a public consultation on them in the March-April period.
- **Vietnam:** EAGL membership has been finalized by the Regional Vice Chair for South East Asia and the Regional and Associate Reviewers. Confirmed members will be notified in March and training will take place in March-April.
- **Switzerland:** EAGL membership has been finalized by the Regional Vice Chair for Europe and the Regional Reviewer. Confirmed members will be notified in March and training will take place in March.
- **European Union:** IUCN invites Natura 2000 (N2K) site managers to apply for participation in the testing phase of the 'Green List for N2K' project. Deadline for application: 13th April 2018 (commenced in January 2018) more information available [here](#).
