Hiroko Muraki Gottlieb is Senior Ocean Governance Advisor of Global Marine and Polar Programme, IUCN with over 20 years of legal and policy expertise, covering a broad range of sustainability and international issues. Hiroko engages in diplomacy with various stakeholders, including governments, international organizations, intergovernmental organizations and civil society, including academia. She is a Fellow at the Global Center for Environmental Law, Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University and in that capacity, she trains diplomats at the United Nations on the environment, ocean and diplomacy in the international fora. Hiroko is a frequent invited speaker on ocean governance and sustainability and she has participated in numerous meetings at the United Nations, including as senior legal expert for the IUCN BBNJ delegation. Hiroko also has extensive experience in the private sector.
